

MANUFACTURER IDENTIFICATION GUIDELINES



Using the Emblem of the Games

- Emblem must be sourced directly from IAPGOC
- Only one(1) per item of clothing(maximum size of 20cm²)

| Type of Clothing | Using Logo |
|--|---|
| Non-competition formal wear(opening/closing ceremonies, victory ceremony, team welcome ceremony) | IAPG Emblem (combination with letters) |

** Not be used on any item, except as permitted by the present guidelines*

- Placement : On the left chest or the upper right arm of official uniforms, not adjacent to other logos




<Left chest> or <Upper right arm>




Clothing

- Only one identification of the manufacturer per item unless indicated in the sport-by-sport list (maximum size of 20cm²)




Clothing

- One-piece body suits
 - One(1) above the waist
 - One(1) below the waist
- * *Not appear close or adjacent to each other*
- No manufacturer identification may on or near the neck or the collar





Sports Equipment

- Personal, sport-specific equipment provided and used by athletes (rackets, bicycles, etc.)
- One(1) per item: Maximum size of 60cm², within 10% of the surface area of the item




Accessories

- Items worn or used by athletes and participants
 - One(1) per item : Maximum size of 6cm²
- * Please refer to the Sport-by-Sport section for details on technical requirements of IFs*



Eyewear

- One(1) per item
 - One(1) on one of the arms : 6 cm² (maximum)
 - One(1) on both arms : 3 cm² each (maximum)




Helmet

- One(1) per item
 - One(1) on one of the ears : 6 cm²(maximum)
 - One(1) on both ears : 3 cm² each(maximum)



Others

- Prohibited on Athletes' belongings such as contact lenses, earplugs, mouth guards, nose clips, water bottles, umbrellas



Shoes/Footwear

- Carry the identification as generally used on products sold through the retail trade for 12 months prior to the Games.
