**Re-Introduction of a fee for IWAS Wheelchair Fencing Referee Licence.**

The IWAS Wheelchair Fencing Executive Committee has reintroduced a fee for Referee registration and issuing of licences.

All IWAS Wheelchair Fencing Referees must register/renew their licence on the Ophardt system and pay an annual licence fee of €10. The licence fee will be reintroduced from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 and will run from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.


All Referees must have registered and renewed their licence before attending any IWAS competition. Non-compliance will result in the Referee being unable to attend and officiate at the competition.
